Organization/Assignments

We will be using <u>Google Classroom</u>. This is where the majority of their assignments will be located. As soon as we start using Google Classroom the students will add themselves to our subject classrooms and they will be able to log on at home. Through Google Classroom you will see the list of assignments your child will heed to complete and the date of which they are due.

Your child will bring home a weekly **Thursday folder** with graded work, RLC flyers, etc. (will also attach any pertinent documentation to an email for your convenience.

Schedule

I've attached our **Weekly Special Schedule**. Please note children need to wear rubber-soled, closed-toed shoes (i.e., sneakers) on P.E. days. Also, we will go outside every day for recess, weather permitting. Please encourage your child to wear clothes and outerwear appropriate for the season.

Learning In Our Classroom

As a teacher, there are a few additional things to know about me: (value my job and the opportunity (will have to teach your child many things academically and socially. (believe in setting high standards and challenging your child to meet them. (truly believe in a classroom community that values respect where we can all feel successful. (believe in laughter and hard work as we learn. Mostly, (want to assure you and your child that it will be a year full of fun, challenging experiences, and plenty of memories.

I also believe in having an organized and structured, student-centered learning environment where children will have access and utilize various resources to assist in learning. Some of which include: sticky notes, white boards, google docs/word, ppt, etc. Throughout the day, your child will engage in problem-based tasks, guided inquiry, and cooperative learning activities to construct their understanding of new concepts, while incorporating technology where it makes sense. Some ways we will use technology to enhance our learning include:

- Gather online resources to add to our research study
- Read material on websites, including primary source documents
- View and analyze high-quality color images and media clips
- Connect with their classmates and students in other classes
- Extend knowledge on topics we are learning about in class

In addition to individual tasks, we will work collaboratively in small groups, partnerships, and whole-group discussing, debating, and asking questions to develop a deep understanding of what we're learning.

This method is being used to reduce the number of papers sent home on the first day of school. Prior to the first day of school, **I need to know your child's dismissal plan so that I am aware of how your child will be getting home on the first day of school!** You will receive this form during Open House and then I will be sending out a digital copy for the parents who not able to come to the Open House.
